### Evacuation Procedures

To effectively manage an emergency that may require evacuation it is critical that the organisation evaluates the potential circumstances that may lead to an evacuation, the level of evacuation required, who will initiate an evacuation and when it will occur.

There needs to be a co-ordinated effort from a group of educated individuals to initiate and co-ordinate an evacuation in a safe, efficient and effective manner, from an individual area or an entire building, ensuring all occupants arrive safely at the designated assembly area.

There could be a number of different incidents occur that require specific management processes, however once a decision is made to evacuate, the process must be identical, like water going through a funnel.

The objective when developing and implementing effective evacuation processes is to keep the process simple in design and training, which will help information retention.
